Artentik is a Non-fungible tokens (NFTs) marketplace, registered on the Ethereum blockchain network, linked to images belonging to its art collection, relics, reliquaries, sculptures or artefacts and other objects belonging to its cultural heritage, and authenticated by Santa Casa da Misericórdia de Lisboa.
