In this context, Abreu Advogados also inaugurates a new area of its website – International Sanctions | Legal Monitor - exclusively dedicated to international sanctions where it provides an update on the main sanctions imposed in the context of the Russia-Ukraine conflict and a sectoral analysis of the consequences and impacts that these measures may have for national companies.
