## Watson Farley & Williams advised Cerberus Capital Management on the €175 million acquisition of four Spanish wind farms.

The four wind farms – which have an aggregated capacity of 105.8 MW – are Sierra Sesnández in Zamora (acquired from Sinia Renovables), Loma del Capón in Granada (acquired from Comsa Renovables), Magaz in Palencia (acquired from Esif) and Cova da Serpe II in Lugo (acquired from Renovis).
