Clifford Chance advises the ACS group on the disposal of its photovoltaic power business in Spain to the Portuguese energy company Galp.

The deal includes existing PV plants (with a capacity of circa 900 MW) and projects to be developed in coming years (2020, 2021, 2022 and also 100 MW for 2023), making a total capacity of 2.930 MW. The transaction, for a value of $\[\in \]$ 2.2 billion (enterprise value) is expected to generate a $\[\in \]$ 330 million profit for ACS.
