

CUATRECASAS ADVISES ON BREWERY LAUNCH IN SEVILLE

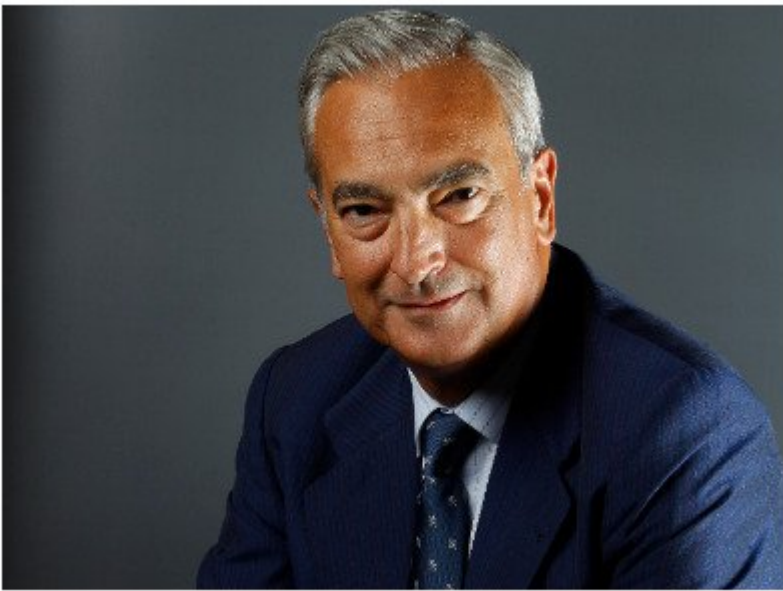
