With the sale of these assets, which include the integrated cement plant in Malaga, three aggregates plants and 11 ready-mix concrete plants in Andalusia, Votorantim Cimentos further strengthens its business in Spain and creates significant synergies with its existing operations.

Votorantim Cimentos currently has five integrated cement plants, two grinding plants, one mortar plant and several concrete and aggregates plants, located in Andalusia, the Canary Islands, Castilla y León, Extremadura and Galicia. HeidelbergCement is considered one of the world's largest integrated manufacturers of building materials and solutions
