In José María Gil-Robles' words, "replacing a person with the sensitivity and energy of Matilde Fernández in the presidency of UNHCR Spain Committee, and doing it in the complicated times we are experiencing, with figures of refugees and displaced people who do not stop growing, is an extraordinary challenge, which I face with great enthusiasm and with the peace of mind of having the UNHCR Spain team behind, led by Francesco Sciacca."
