
HERBERT SMITH FREEHILLS MADRID ANNOUNCES 7% REVENUE INCREASE

According to a firm statement, highlights for the Madrid office in 2017 included advising Abengoa on the sale of a 25 per cent \$607 million stake in Atlantica Yield to the Canadian company Algonquin Power & Utilities. The firm also advised Brookfield Asset

Management on the sale of its 27.7 per cent stake in the Chilean company Transelec to China Southern Power Grid for a value of €1.3 billion.
