The two-week International Legal Summer School helps young lawyers to develop their English language skills within a legal framework and soft skills such as negotiation or presentation abilities.



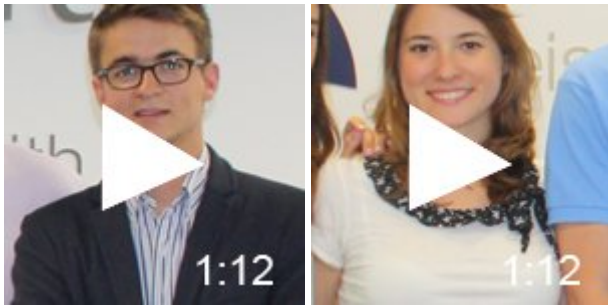

The International Legal Summer School helps prepare students for a successful career as an international lawyer. Building upon the basic blocks of legal English, the course also provides with an important knowledge of the English legal approach (known as Common Law).

Speaking and writing in English is only one part of the challenge. Participants also receive hands-on practical experience at putting language into practice – advising clients, negotiating agreements and debating with other participants in English.

Learning based upon real life situations

The Summer School’s approach to learning is practical and interactive. Class sizes are small and participants will follow real life scenarios based upon the faculty’s own experiences within law firms.

Participants will gain an understanding of the following key elements:

- The language skills required to work as a lawyer in English;
- The basic concepts of US and English (Common Law) business law and main differences with Civil Law;
- Drafting, negotiating and communicating legal issues in English;
- Business law concepts and International business transactions.
