The operation, valued at €225 million, includes the change of ownership of Selene Hospitales, a hospital information system widely implemented in Spain.

The transaction involves the change of ownership of Cerner Medico subsidiaries, Soarian Health Archive, Soarian Integrated Care and Selene -the latter widely used in hospitals in our country.

Cerner is an American health technology solutions, services and devices provider listed on Nasdaq (CERN), and its customer base comprises 251 hospitals in Germany and 65 public hospitals in Spain.

The operation was carried out by a multidisciplinary cross-border team led by Madrid office Commercial counsel Ignacio Domínguez Mateos (pictured left) and Düsseldorf office Commercial partner Natalie Daghles (pictured right).
