Law students have voted Garrigues as the best employer to work for in Spain in a new survey.



The 2018 Most Attractive Employer Survey – conducted by employer branding company Universum – sought the opinions of 2,200 law students, most of whom highlighted Garrigues' prestige, success in the market and its talented lawyers as among the main reasons why they wanted to work there.
