

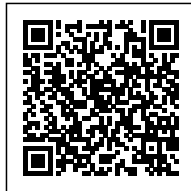
# ORLEGI TAKES OVER SPORTING DE GIJÓN: THE ADVISORS

The Mexican group Orlegi Sports has acquired s majority stake in Sporting de Gijón's share capital.
