
PLATINA ADVISED BY WATSON FARLEY & WILLIAMS ON PHOTOVOLTAIC PLANT RESTRUCTURING

Watson Farley & Williams (WFW) advised international energy fund Platina Partners on the restructuring of its Anemoi Cantillana photovoltaic plant in Seville using a loan from Unicredit.

WFW also recently advised Platina on the restructuring of its photovoltaic plants at Morón (Seville) and Mesa de Ocaña (Toledo), deals that were also financed by Unicredit. The combined installed capacity of the three plants is 20 MW.
