PLMJ advised TAP Air Portugal on the sale of a 51 per cent stake in the duty free shop business Lajos Frances de Portugal (LFP) to French airports operator Vinci Airports.

LFP has 29 shops in five different airports. Swiss company <u>Dufry</u> will retain a 49 per cent stake in the business.

The deal was valued at €15.6 million.

LFP employs around 500 people and generated revenue of approximately €200 million in 2016.

<u>Vinci Airports</u> operates 35 airports worldwide and catered for 132.3 million passengers last year.
