
SÉRVULO CONFIRMS MEMBERSHIP OF CHINA-FOCUSED LAW FIRM NETWORK

Portuguese law firm Sérvulo has confirmed it has joined a new international network focusing on the Chinese market.

The network, called Cathay Associates, was established by Beijing-based boutique law firm Kejie Law Office.

The Cathay Associates website claims that Spanish firm Rousaud Costas Duran (RCD) is also a member of the network, with RCD partner Ignasi Costas listed as the network contact for Barcelona and Madrid.
