

Portugal's 'big three' increase revenue

Revenue grew at Portugal's three biggest law firms in the last year, according to *The Lawyer European 100* rankings. **Morais Leitão, Galvão Teles, Soares da Silva (MLGTS)** moved up four places to 77th with a 2014 revenue of €40m (up 6 per cent from €37.7m the previous year), while **Vieira de Almeida (VdA)** climbed two places to 83rd with revenue of €36.4m (up 4 per cent from €35m in 2013). Meanwhile, **PLMJ** was the highest climber, leaping seven places to equal 84th with a 2014 revenue of €36m (up an impressive 9 per cent on the 2013 total of €33m).
